County of Madison

The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Monday, April 25, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. at the Madison County Public Library Marshall Branch, 1335 N. Main Street, Marshall, North Carolina.

In attendance were Chairman Mark Snelson, Vice-Chairman Craig Goforth, Commissioner and Interim County Manager Norris Gentry, Commissioner Matt Wechtel, Commissioner Michael Garrison, and Clerk Mandy Bradley.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Snelson.

**Item 1: Consideration of Appointment of Noise Ordinance Appeal Board**

Commissioner Gentry requested to skip the item until a later date.

**Item 2: FY 2022-2023 Budget Discussion**

Finance Officer Kary Ledford presented budgetary allocation requests for the FY 2022-2023 budget to the Board as well as answered questions from Board members. Information discussed included insuring a balanced budget, potential funding allocations and other items contained in the proposed budget including capital building projects, vehicle requests, and ongoing expenses.

Discussion was had by the Board and Ms. Ledford.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry and second by Commissioner Wechtel, the Board voted unanimously to go to recess at 4:44 p.m.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry and second by Chairman Snelson, the Board voted unanimously to return to open session at 5:14 p.m.

Discussion was had by the Board regarding capital equipment requests and nonprofit funding requests including the request from Pisgah Legal for funding in the amount of \$10,000.00.

Upon motion by Commissioner Wechtel and second by Commissioner Garrison, the Board voted 2-3 against allocating \$5,000.00 to Pisgah Legal with Commissioner Wechtel and Commissioner Garrison voting in favor and Chairman Snelson, Vice-Chairman Goforth, and Commissioner Gentry voting opposed.


Further discussion was had by the Board regarding budgetary information including funding from the American Rescue Plan Act, salary allocations, and revenues.


