The United States set COVID-19 records for a fourth consecutive day, with more than 184,000 cases reported November 13. The same day there were more than 68,000 people hospitalized with the virus, more than at any other point during the pandemic, according to data from the COVID Tracking Project. An average of over 1,100 Americans have died per day of the virus over the last week. There has been more than one million COVID-19 infections Nationally, just in the last week. More than 13,100 people in the U.S. are currently in the ICU, according to the COVID Tracking Project's data.

Nationally, there were 144,000 new cases of COVID-19 on November 14 and 1,244 deaths from the virus.

The seven-day average of daily new cases has hit records every day for at least the past ten days, according to data compiled by Johns Hopkins University.
