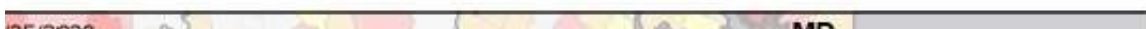

The United States on Friday once again saw a record number of Covid-19 cases, when more than 98,500 infections were recorded. It is the fifth time since Oct. 22 that a new national daily case record was set.
