The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services reported the state's highest one-day number of COVID-19 cases with 4,296 new cases. The record-high day follows several days of increasing trends in new cases, the percent of tests that are positive and hospitalizations. This marks the fifth day this month that the state has reported more than 3,000 cases. The state reported 3,367 new cases on 11/18/2020 and 3,885 new cases on 11/14/2020.

At least 1,538 people were hospitalized with COVID-19 as of 11/19/2020, also a new record.

On Saturday November 21, 2020 there were 195,000 new cases in the U.S.

Pfizer and Moderna continue to move forward with plans to apply for emergency use authorization, from the FDA, for their COVID-19 vaccine.
