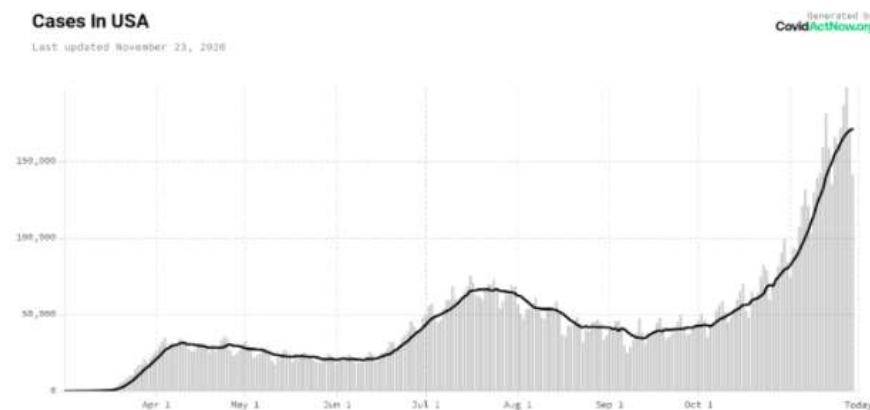

Over the last week, Madison County, North Carolina has averaged 10 new confirmed cases per day (**44.7** for every 100,000 residents). Over the next year, this translates to around 3,500 cases and an [estimated](#) 18,000 infections (81.5% of the population).
