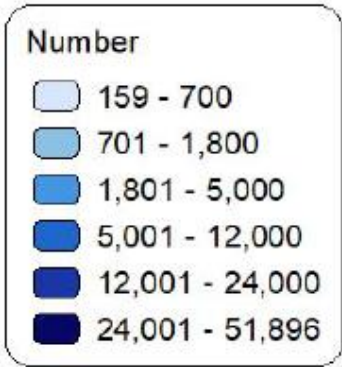
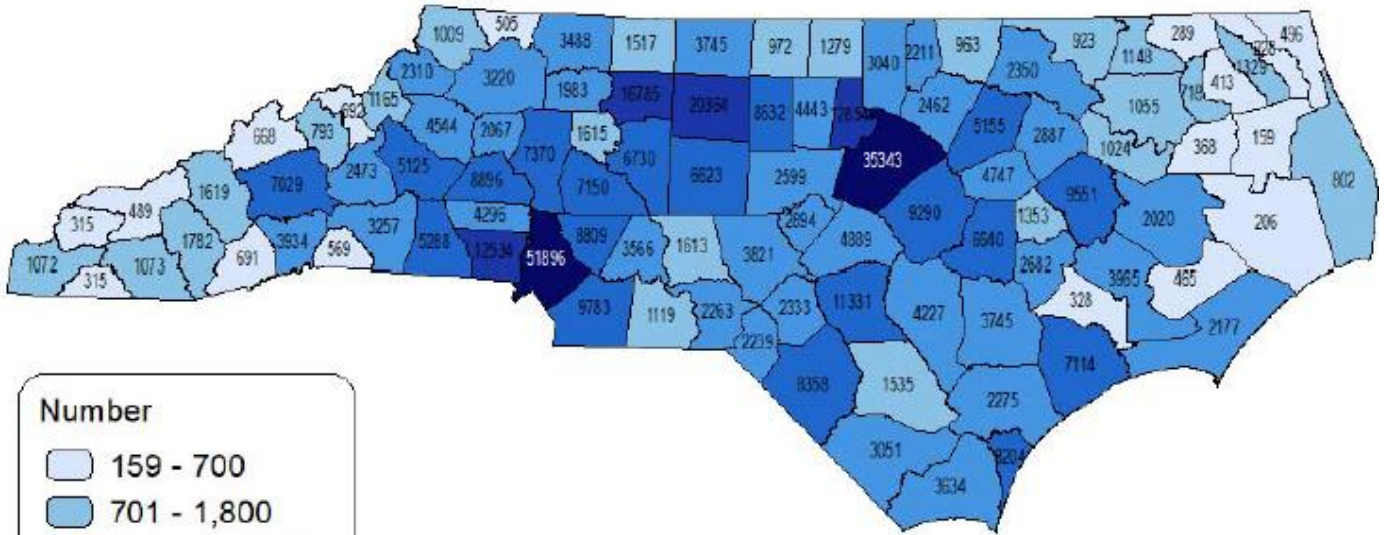

The N.C. Department of Health and Human Services on Sunday, December 14, 2020 reported 6,819 new COVID-19 cases, up from 6,153 the day before.

At least 2,520 people in North Carolina were hospitalized with COVID-19 as of Sunday. This is the second highest total reported since the start of the pandemic. The record, 2,577 hospitalizations, was reported Saturday, December 12, 2020. About 11.6% of tests were reported positive as of Friday, December, 11 the latest day for which data are available.
