The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Monday, August 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at AB Tech Madison Campus, Marshall, NC.

In attendance were Chairman Wayne Brigman, Vice-Chairman Norris Gentry, Commissioner Clayton Rice, Commissioner Matthew Wechtel, Commissioner Bill Briggs, Attorney Donny Laws, County Manager Forrest Gilliam and Clerk Amanda Cutshaw.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Item 1: Laurel School Property

The commissioners heard from Laurel Community Center LLC, consisting of residents of the Shelton Laurel Community, about their desire to turn the former school into a community center.

County Attorney, Donny Laws, explained that the building was still owned by the school board and the various legal restrictions on conveyance of the property and its uses.

The group then explained their plans to the commissioners and outlined their financial requests.

The commissioners and members of Laurel Community Center, LLC agreed to meet again in 4 to 6 weeks and discuss more concrete plans, including repairs to or replacement of the septic system.

Item 2: Adjournment

Upon motion from Vice-Chairman Gentry, seconded by Commissioner Rice, the board voted unanimously to adjourn.
