DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

The following declaration is issued by the Board of Commissioners of Madison County:

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death by
the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which is a new strain of Coronavirus previously unidentified in humans
and which can spread from person to person; and

WHEREAS, in response to the global spread of the virus and the disease it causes, the World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") has warned of the high public health threat posed by COVID-19 globally and in the United States and has deemed it necessary to prohibit or restrict travel to areas designated by the CDC; the United States Department of Health and Human Services Secretary declared a public health emergency in the United States for COVID-19; and the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services ("NCDHHS") confirmed multiple cases of COVID-19 in North Carolina as of March 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020 the State of North Carolina, through the Office of the Governor, Roy Cooper, issued Executive Order No. 116 titled "Declaration of a State of Emergency to Coordinate Response and Protective Actions to Prevent the spread of Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, in consultation with health care professionals and based upon guidance from the CDC and NCDHHS arrangements must be made immediately to take such actions as are deemed necessary and appropriate to ensure that COVID-19 remains controlled and that residents and visitors in Madison County remain safe and secure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority contained in the Madison County

State of Emergency Ordinance and Article 1A of the N.C.G.S. Chapter 166A, the Board of Commissioners,

do hereby declare a Local State of Emergency for Madison County beginning upon adoption of this

Declaration and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

By and with the consent of the mayors of the municipalities within Madison County this

Declaration of Local State of Emergency applies within the municipal limits in the Town of Marshall,

the Town of Mars Hill, and the Town of Hot Springs.

It is further declared that the Emergency Management Plan adopted by Madison County, and

that all applicable mutual assistance compacts and agreements are in effect and shall remain in effect

until this Declaration expires or is rescinded. All Emergency Management and Health and Medical

Services personnel are hereby ordered to cooperate in the implementations of the provisions of the

County's Emergency Management Plan.

We direct that copies of this Declaration be disseminated to the mass communications media

for publication and broadcast, and that a copy of this Declaration be posted at the County Courthouse

and other public buildings as appropriate.
