Closed Session General Account

The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in closed session on Friday, May 29, 2020 at the North Carolina Cooperative Extension-Madison County Center located at 258 Carolina Lane, Marshall, North Carolina. Pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11 (a) (3) to consult with an attorney regarding Madison Asphalt, LLC vs. Madison County Case Number 19-CVS-340, the Board entered into closed session at 9:07 a.m.
