North Carolina COVID-19 Metrics

North Carolina has relied on science, real-time data, and key metrics to guide its pandemic response. As we move into this next phase, some of those key metrics no longer meet the current need.

Beginning on March 23, 2022, the Summary page of the NCDHHS COVID-19 Dashboard Summary Page will be updated weekly on Wednesdays and will include Wastewater Surveillance, COVID-Like Illness in Emergency Departments, Hospital Admissions, COVID-19 Cases, Booster Rates, Prevalence of Variants, and CDC COVID-19 Community Levels data. In addition, the Dashboard will no longer include testing or contract tracing.

Updated Monday-Friday by the NC Department of Health and Human Services at approximately noon. Last updated 12:15 p.m., March 21, 2022.

Delays in laboratories reporting tests to NCDHHS may occur as laboratories are processing unprecedented numbers of COVID-19 tests.
