

Notice of General Election November 3, 2020

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to G. S. 163-33(8), that a general election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and include federal, state, and county contests.

The polls will be open for voting on Tuesday, November 3 (Election Day) from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

The voter registration deadline is Friday, October 9 at 5:00 p.m.

Same Day Registration during one-stop voting **is allowed** in this election.

Out-of-precinct voting on Election Day **is allowed** in this election.

Voters will NOT be required to show photo ID for the November 3 general election. In a December 31 order, a federal district court blocked North Carolina's voter photo ID requirement from taking effect. The injunction will remain in place until further order of the court.

All Madison County voters may vote at any one (1) of the three (3) one-stop absentee voting sites.

All one-stop sites are open for voting from Thursday, October 15 to Saturday, October 31.

All one-stop sites are open on weekdays (Monday-Friday) from 8:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.; Saturdays October 17 and 24 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and Saturday, October 31 from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots by mail will be available starting Friday, September 4. The deadline for applying for an absentee ballot by mail is 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 27. Mailed ballots must be returned on or before Election Day, November 3 by 5:00 p.m. or must be postmarked on or before Election Day, November 3.

All absentee meetings will be held at the Board of Elections Office located at 140 Elizabeth Lane, Marshall, NC 28753.

Absentee Meetings will be held at 2:00 p.m. all Tuesdays and Fridays beginning September 29 to October 30. Additional absentee meetings will be held at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 2; at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3; and at 9:00 a.m.

on Tuesday, November 10 and Thursday, November 12. The canvass meeting will be held Friday, November 13 at 11:00 a.m. Preparatory steps to count absentee ballots will be taken during each absentee meeting.
