Minutes

County of Madison

The Madison County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the North Carolina Cooperative Extension-Madison County Center located at 258 Carolina Lane, Marshall, North Carolina.

In attendance were Chairman Mark Snelson, Vice-Chairman Craig Goforth, Commissioner and Interim County Manager Norris Gentry, Commissioner Matt Wechtel, Commissioner Michael Garrison, County Attorney Donny Laws, and Clerk Mandy Bradley.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Snelson.

Chairman Snelson opened the floor for public comment sign up.

Agenda Item 1: Agenda Approval

Upon motion by Commissioner Wechtel and second by Vice-Chairman Goforth, the Board voted unanimously that the agenda be approved as published.

Agenda Item 2: Approval of September 14, 2021 (Special) Minutes; September 14, 2021 (Regular) Minutes; September 27, 2021 (Special) Minutes

Upon motion by Vice-Chairman Goforth and second by Commissioner Garrison, the Board voted unanimously to approve as presented.

Agenda Item 3: Public Comment

Ann Zook- Ms. Zook spoke regarding Paint Rock Farm and noise concerns.

Gloria Sundquist- Ms. Sundquist spoke regarding the County's Noise Ordinance and noise complaints regarding Paint Rock Farm. (Attachment 3.1)

Agenda Item 4: Teresa Stevens, Givens Communities

Ms. Stevens attended remotely along with Tonya Haddock and Andrew Crosson and presented information to the Board as well as answered questions from Board members regarding Givens Communities and proposal addressing housing needs in Western North Carolina to help seniors age independently. Information discussed included affordable housing, the demographic to be served, the housing gap in Madison County, and potential sites in the County for housing as well as funding sources.

Agenda Item 5: Public Hearing-2011 Community Development Block Grant Closeout

Commissioner Gentry opened the public hearing for Scattered Site Program 11-C-2318 and presentation by Erica Anderson from Land of Sky Regional Council.

a. Scattered Site Program 11-C-2318 Presentation, Erica Anderson-Land of Sky

Ms. Anderson presented and discussed the close out of the Community Development Block Grant from 2011. Information discussed included the number of clients served and client demographic as well as the amount spent with Ms. Anderson noting that the final step in the program was to close out the project.

b. Public Comment

No public comment was available to be heard by the Board.

c. Discussion

Discussion was had by the Board and Ms. Anderson regarding the areas and demographics served by the grant.

d. Approval of Closeout Performance Report

Commissioner Gentry made a motion to close the public hearing and approve the closeout performance report. Counsel was provided by County Attorney Laws regarding closing the public hearing and the approval of the closeout report, the motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Goforth, the Board voted unanimously to close the public hearing.

Upon motion by Commissioner Wechtel and second by Vice-Chairman Goforth, the Board voted unanimously to close out the performance report. (Attachment 5.4)

Item 6: Kary Ledford, Finance Officer

a. Budget Amendment #4

Ms. Ledford presented and discussed Budget Amendment #4 with the Board as well as answered questions from board members.

Upon motion by Vice-Chairman Goforth and second by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to approve Budget Amendment #4. (Attachment 6.1)

b. Financial Report

The financial report for the month of September was presented to the Board by Ms. Ledford who answered questions from board members regarding the report. (Attachment 6.2)

c. Purchasing Policy Amendment Consideration

An amendment to the County's purchasing policy was presented by Ms. Ledford for consideration of the Board. Ms. Ledford noted that the amendments would allow for compliance with North Carolina Department of Transportation standards regarding bid protests and records retention.

Counsel was provided by County Attorney Laws who noted that an audit of the Transportation Department found the current policy to be deficient and discussion was had by the Board.

Upon motion by Vice-Chairman Goforth and second by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to approve based upon that. (Attachment 6.3)

Agenda Item 7: Diana Norton, Tax Assessor

Ms. Norton presented the tax refunds and releases for the month of September to the Board. Discussion was had by Ms. Norton and board members regarding adjustments.

Upon motion by Commissioner Wechtel and second by Commissioner Gentry, the Board voted unanimously to approve as submitted. (Attachment 7.1)

Agenda Item 8: Norris Gentry, Commissioner/Interim County Manager

a. County Manager's Update

Commissioner Gentry discussed budget proposals of the Senate and the House. Information discussed by Commissioner Gentry and the Board included the last mile broadband installation, grants in rural counties, changes in rural health, workforce housing funding, downtown projects, and water and sewer grants.

The County Noise Ordinance and noise complaint reports from the County's Emergency Management Office were discussed with the Board by Commissioner Gentry who also read portions of the existing Ordinance into the record. Discussion regarding the Ordinance and enforcement was had by the Board with counsel being provided by County Attorney Laws.

Commissioner Gentry discussed the Ivy Watershed and the Town of Weaverville's access as well as consumption with the Board. Discussion was had by the Board.

Recent mitigation to issues of the roof at the jail were presented and discussed with the board by Commissioner Gentry and counsel was provided by County Attorney Laws regarding records for the roof warranty.

b. County Board Appointments

Commissioner Gentry discussed the vacancy for the Housing Authority Board. Discussion was had by the Board with no action being taken.

c. Personnel, d. Property, Agenda Item 9: Donny Laws, County Attorney

County Attorney Laws requested that the Board enter into closed session to discuss the National Opioid Settlement.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry and second by Vice-Chairman Goforth, the Board voted unanimously to enter into closed session for personnel, property, and legal pursuant to N.C.G.S 143-318.11 (a) (6) and N.C.G.S 143-318.11 (a) (3) at 8:15 p.m.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry and second by Chairman Snelson, the Board voted unanimously to return to open session at 9:11 p.m.

Human Resources Director Brooke Ledford requested authorization to post the advertisement seeking the American Rescue Plan Act Grant Manager position for the County. Upon motion by Commissioner Gentry and second by Commissioner Garrison, the Board voted unanimously to approve.

Agenda Item 10: Adjournment

Commissioner Gentry made a motion to adjourn and meet again in two weeks at 4:00 p.m. Discussion was had by the Board noting that the meeting would be at 5:00 p.m. two weeks from today on September 26th. The meeting was adjourned at 9:13 p.m.

#### ADDENDUM TO THE MADISON COUNTY PURCHASING POLICY:

When using federal funds, the County must follow NC Statutes as well as OMB Guidance provided in the Code of Federal Regulations, Subpart D - Post Federal Award Requirements. The thresholds for micropurchases, small purchases, and when sealed bids are required are set by OMB Guidance provided in the Code of Federal Regulations Title 2 Vol. 1 § 200.67 and § 200.88. This guidance includes but is not limited to the following requirements:

- i. Micro-purchases (\$0 \$9,999) When practical, distribute micro-purchases among qualified suppliers.
- ii. Small Purchases (\$10,000 \$249,999) a. Price rate quotations must be obtained from an adequate number of qualified sources. b. Written procurement procedures to define number and methods for obtaining quotes.
- iii. Sealed Bid Procedures Required (\$250,000 and higher) a. Price rate quotations must be obtained from an adequate number of qualified sources; b. Publicly advertised; c. Competitive proposals; d. Non-competitive proposals require written approval and justification (e.g. only one source/vendor available, inadequate competition, emergency).
- iv. Documentation required (All amounts) a. Evidence the awarded supplier is not excluded from doing business with the Federal Government. b. When quotes are required, documentation that an attempt was made to contact at least three suppliers to obtain quotes.

When Federal Funds have been used, the County must maintain records detailing history of each procurement action for a period of seven years after the submission of final expenditure reports. These records will include but not limited to the following: rationale for the method of procurement, selection of contract type, contractor selection or rejection, and the basis for the contract price. See 2 CFR 200.318 and FTA Circular 4220

- I. Purpose: The purpose of this document is to provide procedures for filing protests or complaints about any procurement of services, materials or supplies, by Madison County Government funded in whole or part with Federal funds.
- II. II. Procedure Statement: These procedures provide for the filing of a protest or complaint in three circumstances:
  - 1. By a party who did not submit a bid or proposal.
  - 2. By a party who has responded to an invitation for bid (IFB), a request for proposals (RFP) or a request for quotes (RFQ).
  - 3. By a prospective contractor or bidder who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation or award of a contract.
    - If the protesting party does not submit a bid or proposal (category #1 above), the protest must be submitted prior to the date of the bid opening for the bid or prior to the date on which the proposal or quote is due to be received by Madison County.
    - Any protests received after those dates will not be reviewed or considered and will be dismissed as untimely.
    - For those protestors who fall into categories #2 and #3, their protests must be filed within twenty (20) calendar days of the date of award approval. Untimely protests will be dismissed.
    - The date the protest is filed will be considered the received date in the Finance Department. A protest must be submitted in writing and sent to:

Madison County Finance Department PO Box 579 Marshall, NC 28753

- Each protest must specify the reasons the protesting party believes that the solicitation or award was improper. Issues not raised in the written protest are deemed waived and may not be raised on appeal. The protesting party may submit with the protest any documents or information deemed relevant.
- A copy of the protest will be forwarded to the Finance Director, the County Attorney and the Madison County department that is responsible for the procurement. The Finance Director and/or County Attorney shall review the protest and submit any response or reply. They may also request to review any additional documents or information deemed necessary to render a decision.
- After the review process has been completed, one or more of the following decisions will be rendered:
  - Dismiss the protest for reason o Continue with the recommended award
  - Cancel the award and re-bid the project, or
  - Any combination of the above.

- If the decision is made after the execution of the contract and the contractor did not act fraudulently, the following action(s) may be taken:
- -The contract may be ratified and affirmed provided it is determine that to do so is in the best interest of the county.
- -The contract may be cancelled and the contractor compensated for the actual expenses reasonably incurred under the contract prior to termination where such compensation shall not include loss of anticipated profit, loss of use of money or administrative or overhead costs, including but not limited to attorneys' fees and legal expenses.
- If it determined that the contractor has acted improperly, the contract may be:
- Declared void, modified to comply with the law, with the consent of all parties, or
- -Ratified and affirmed, provided it is determined that action is in the best interests of the county and without prejudice to the county's right to damages, as may be appropriate.
- A copy of the decision will be sent to the protesting party and any other person determined to be affected by the decision.

#### III. Definitions:

IV. Applicability: These procedures apply to projects funded in whole or part with Federal funds.

#### V. Procedure Responsibility and Management: This section outlines:

- Enforcement This procedure has been approved by the County Manager and the Madison County Board of Commissioners. The Finance Director has the delegated authority for the enforcement and management of this procedure.
- Review—The Finance Department will review this procedure annually. If warranted, the procedure will be updated and submitted through the review and approval process in force at the time.
- Communication The Finance Department has the responsibility for disseminating, reviewing, modifying, updating and interpreting this procedure. Within the department, the responsibility is delegated to the Finance Director.
